1.	In addition to the drawings of the existing building the issued competition materials also contain drawings of the plans of the LGS tower while no tower is seen in elevation drawings. Such information would be necessary for proper modelling of the existing situation. Is it possible to receive elevation drawings of the tower as well?	The elevation drawing of the LGS tower will be prepared and sent to all participants.
2.	<p>1. Given the 360-degree horizontal viewing angle of the tower cab, do the tower lifts reach the cab or do they only reach the level below?</p> <p>2. The number of parking spaces required in the territory is given as “up to”, does it mean that it is allowed to provide twice as less parking spaces?</p>	<p>1. To provide a 360-degree angle of view, the tower lift only goes up to Level 6 of the tower, and Level 7 can be reached via stairs, which, if necessary, may be equipped with a seat for people with reduced mobility.</p> <p>2. The expected/desired number of parking spaces in indicated in the Designing Programme.</p>
3.	Is the number of A1-size panels to be submitted unlimited? As the recent competitions in Latvia have proved, this factor may become an obstacle to an impartial Jury’s assessment, therefore we would like to have an explanation on this issue.	The number of A1-size panels is not defined. The participants must arrange the graphical materials that are requested in the competition documents logically and comprehensibly and in appropriate scale.
4.	<p>I have a question about Appendix 4 of the LGS competition: “Participant’s experience in provision of equivalent services”; does the following experience comply with the requirement?</p> <p>1. A construction design for a public building, 2016, 32,000 m2, including landscaping of the territory of more than 1000 m2, a solution for transport infrastructure and engineering communications, incl. contact details of the recipient of the service and a feedback letter about this object.</p> <p>2. A sketch design for a high-rise public building, 2015, 12,000 m2, height 70m – as a competition entry, but developed according to all requirements and in close cooperation with the engineering and design office. Since it is a competition entry, is it necessary to indicate the organisers of the competition for contact information?</p>	Yes, these qualification requirements comply with Clause 3.3.1 of the Brief, which need to be listed in the sample table of Appendix 4 to the Competition Brief.
